

# THE INTERNATIONAL IMPERIAL COURT SYSTEM EST. 1965

#### History

The International Imperial Court System was founded in 1965 by World War II veteran Jose Julio Sarria, a Hispanic gay activist who in 1961 became the first openly gay candidate to run for public office in North America. "From a seed planted in San Francisco, it grew into a strong royal oak tree with its branches now stretching over Canada, Mexico and the U.S.A." Empress I Jose passed in 2013 at the young age of 90 years.

In 2007 Empress I Jose crowned her heir and successor, San Diego City Commissioner Nicole Murray Ramirez, a gay Latino activist for over 45 years. Empress Nicole The Great was crowned and proclaimed "Queen Mother I of the Americas" and is the CEO, Chairman and "Titular Leader" of the International Imperial Court System.

In 2017 Queen Mother I Nicole the Great celebrated the 10th anniversary of her reign "The Renaissance Era"!









#### THE INTERNATIONAL IMPERIAL COURT COUNCIL

Established by Empress I Jose it serves as the governing body of the IICS. Currently its CEO and Chairman is City Commissioner Nicole Murray Ramirez (Queen Mother I of the Americas). The members of the International Imperial Council are "heirs" to the Queen Mother and are representatives from all over the U.S.A., Canada & Mexico.
